# **Visiting the Centre**

UNEP-WCMC is 1.6 miles north-west of Cambridge city centre, 2 miles from the bus station and 3 miles from the train station. Bike stands and car parking are both available on site.

### Arriving by Bus

From the city centre bus station on Emmanuel Street you can take either the Citi 5 or Citi 6 bus up to Huntingdon Road. There is a stop very near UNEP-WCMC named Howes Place. UNEP-WCMC is signed down a small lane next to the Beefeater Restaurant. UNEP-WCMC is the last building down the lane.

From the train station on Station Road, you will first need to catch either a Citi 1, 3, 7, 8, 99, or the busway c bus from the bus stop on the right hand side as you walk out of the station. Then take the Citi 5 or 6 from the city centre. See details above.

The Stagecoach Dayrider ticket purchased on any bus costs £3.90 and allows unlimited travel on buses within Cambridge for a day. After 18:30 it may be advisable to take a taxi instead.

# Arriving by Coach

- Coaches arrive at parkside near the city centre.
- Coaches operate from all airports and can provide a more direct route. If travelling to London Luton airport coach travel is advised as it is a more direct route than the train.
- No booking is required, although they can be booked online at <u>National Express</u>.

### Arriving by Train

- Trains from London King's Cross Station and London Liverpool Street to Cambridge run every half hour. Return fare from £16.00 depending on time of travel (if off-peak).
- Tickets can be purchased in advance from National Rail or The Trainline
- A taxi from the train station to UNEP-WCMC costs around £10.

#### Arriving by Car

Free car parking is available on site.

- Travelling on the M11 (from the South and London): Leave M11 at junction 13 and turn right for Cambridge. Take fifth left, into Storey's Way, passing through narrow bollards, and continue to T-junction. At T-junction, turn left into Huntingdon Road. The UNEP-WCMC driveway is on the left about 1/4 mile on, just before the Beefeater restaurant. UNEP-WCMC is at the end of the driveway.
- Travelling on A14 (from the East and Newmarket/Bury St Edmunds/Ipswich): Take the Cambridge (Histon) turn off, B1049. Turn left for Cambridge at the roundabout. Travel straight along this road for about two miles towards the city centre, until the road ends at a large junction with a double set of traffic lights. Turn right here, then almost immediately

- right again into Huntingdon Road. The UNEP-WCMC driveway is on the left about 1/2 mile on, just before the Beefeater restaurant. UNEP-WCMC is at the end of the driveway.
- Travelling on the A14 (from the North and Huntingdon): From the A14 take the A1307 towards Cambridge city centre, passing Girton College and a BP garage on the left. The UNEP—WCMC driveway is on the right, 400 metres on, just after the Travellers' Rest restaurant. UNEP-WCMC is at the end of the driveway.
